

## Scholarship Rules 2026-2027

Applicant for this award shall be a graduating high school senior or student enrolled in and institution of higher learning; must have a 3.0 GPA

Applicant must be a resident of the state of West Virginia.

Applicant must attend an in-state school which is accredited and above the high school level.

Applicant may attend college/university or technical school, beauty school, nursing, etc.

Applicant must be of good character and have grades which meet entrance requirements at the institution of his/her choice.

Applicant must submit a transcript of their high school grades, if graduating; or a transcript of the most recent classes and grades received from a school of higher learning they are attending.

If a graduating high school senior, applicant must submit a letter of acceptance and registration for classes from the institution of higher learning he/she plans to attend.

If enrolled at an institution of higher learning, applicant must submit an official transcript of classes completed and grades received.

Applicant must send the completed application packet to Knight Templar Education Foundation Secretary to be received on or before May 1st: **no exceptions. Address is at the top of the application. Regular mail is preferred, Do not** send certified.

If you do not attend school in West Virginia the funds must be returned to the Committee.

Scholarships are provided without regard to sex, race, national origin or relationship to any member of the fraternity. The committee seeks applicants who will be able to complete a degree or acceptance in a chosen field and contribute to the workforce of West Virginia.
